HERMITAGE, COROMANDEL, BEAU BASSIN** and indicating the closing date should be addressed to the **Chief Executive, Municipal Council of Beau Bassin Rose Hill** and should be deposited in the bid box at the Administration Department, Town Hall, Rose Hill, so as to reach the Municipal Council **on or before 02 July 2019 by 14hr30(Local time) at latest**. Electronic bidding shall not be permitted and late bids will be rejected.
7. Bids will be opened in the Council Room of the Municipal Council on the same day **at 14.45 hrs** in the presence of bidders/bidders' representatives who choose to attend.
8. The Municipal Council reserves the right to:
 - (a) Accept or reject any bid; and
 - (b) Reject all bids, or
 - (c) Cancel the public procurement proceedings at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid as per provision of Section 39(1) of the Public Procurement Act 2006.
